

# Minuteman Handbook

## Chapter 14

### Conclusion

The final chapter of a book such as this one is supposed to focus the readers attention to some type of action as dictated by the previous chapters. If this were taken literally, this chapter would be an outline for mayhem, considering what you have been taught throughout this book.

The motivation to compile this book at this time was prompted by many circumstances. The author does not consider himself a prophet or receiver of any mystical messages. Anyone taking the time to analyze history, current events and unaltered news, would likely come to the same conclusions.

It seems to be human nature not to accept the apparent, even when it hits us squarely between the eyes! There were many of us who worked against impossible odds in hopes of electing a patriotic president in 1964. We thought that this was a final chance to turn things around — so to speak. A final chance to stop or at least slow down the mad rush into a socialist America. To witness the landslide election of a collectivist demagogue was a crushing defeat, even to those of us who, down deep, feared that America had already passed the point of no return.

Anyone who remains aware of the world around them and sounds the alert when they foresee danger are treated differently by the people with whom they come in contact. Some treat them as prophets or leaders with wisdom beyond the norm. Others regard them as para-

noid cynics and hasten to exit their company. Another large group agrees that America has some serious problems to face, but feels helpless to do anything about it. If they do, it is usually to “work within the system” to correct it. This translates to working and giving to one of our major political parties or perhaps a new third party. They become conditioned by party propaganda and misled by the major media. Any correct decisions they make are more by accident than design.

To go on and on analyzing the different segments of our population would serve no beneficial end. However, we need to focus on a small, very small portion of our American citizens who have, for several years, foreseen that America is past the point of no return. Bluntly put, there is no action “within the system” that can sufficiently and permanently-change our course of events to more pleasant times. Things could be changed — action could be taken, but the requirements would be so politically incorrect and drastic that they could never be implemented within our system. We're not advocating revolution — we're advocating counter-revolution! A socialist, one world revolution has evolved over the past few decades to within a few years of total success.

Unfortunately, most people equate revolutions with the banana republic type, where the term RPM could be applied. Revolutions know no time frame. If you don't believe this, so be it. If you are so blind not to realize our predicament, then

there's little need in wasting time trying to convince you now!

While flying an airplane in an assumed level flight over level ground you suddenly notice the altimeter slowly unwinding and the rate of climb indicator shows a negative reading. Regardless of how slight these readings might be, you can be assured of one thing — if you don't take evasive action you're going to crash! The lower the altitude the more quickly this evasive action must be taken. Assuming no outside contributing factors, a good pilot could rectify the situation very quickly. There was a period in time that America could have been turned around. However, if some of the controlling factors behind the scenes stand to benefit immensely from our country flying into the ground, then it's a different story! Several things have happened since 1992 to cause great alarm to those who are alert. Over the last decade or two federal law enforcement agencies have exhibited an ever increasing reckless abandon of their sworn obligation to the U. S. Constitution. Sure our right to keep and bear arms has been under attack for years, but it was more like jabs to a well conditioned boxer. With the 1992 election of a socialist-leaning administration, the diabolical forces to disarm America pulled out the stops — the jabs became rabbit punches and clinches became a carotid hold on the arteries of freedom. However, nothing has compared to the senseless attack that was perpetrated on helpless women and children in Waco, Texas, while the rest of the nation watched complacently. The climax was the infamous “crime bill”, which was passed into law with the help of some of our assumed pro-American, Republican congressmen. By the caving-in of these traitors nearly 200 legal firearms become verboten at the stroke of a pen. It has been well-observed that there exists a very thin line between

stupidity and subversion. It is hard to believe that some of these “conservative” Republicans were that stupid!

The second cause of great alarm was the ramrodding and passage of the GAFT treaty by these same conservative Republicans. These traitors acted against the vast majority of public opinion, especially their own constituents. Why the mad rush to pass something that few even read?

With the results of the election in November 1994 as they were, some naive Americans expect the new Republican majority to reverse the weapons ban of the crime bill! Under the same top leadership that caved into passing this bill? The same Republican leadership that led the effort to ram the GAFT treaty through so quickly that few members of congress actually read this one-way ticket into a one world order? Get serious! These two events, the crime bill and the GAFT treaty, having been forced upon us with such dynamism should awaken even the most passive of patriotic Americans. The one worlders are so close to realizing their nefarious goal they are beginning to get careless.

The most dangerous thing that American Patriots can do is to drop their guard, thinking the past election fixed everything. We are not recommending that you take any immediate action other than studying this handbook. Learn all you can about the principles of guerrilla and psycho-political warfare. Learn all you can about survival. Not the “live in the woods and eat snakes” type of survival; although we don't mean to brush over importance of this either. What we are talking about is economic and physical existence under adverse conditions. For example: a truckers strike, road blockage, or some other event has prevented the

shipment of groceries and food to the stores in your area. Are you prepared for this event? Throw in loss of electric power on top of this and maybe even a gas shortage or something else that would curtail the usage of a motor vehicle! Paranoid I think not. All but the very young will remember the gas shortage of the early 70's. Old timers remember the federal controls, rationing and shortages of WWII. Various natural disasters have caused one or all the above. Are you prepared?

Survival gurus recommend hedging your economic situation with gold in one of the easy to exchange forms. All well and good if you are affluent enough to add a few Krugerrands to your stash. But, if you don't have food, how do you cook a Krugerrand?

It is very easy for concerned and aware people, call them survivalists if you like, to become tunnel-visioned in one area or another. Some will concentrate on firearms and ammunition, obtaining literally dozens of weapons and thousands of rounds of ammunition. Other than arming each member of your family or group the only other reason for such excessive hoarding is to be able to provide for those among us who cannot or will not avail themselves of such items while they can. The economic trading value is to be considered. A few rounds of the right ammunition might someday be worth more than the same weight in gold or silver.

A food reserve, whether long term storage or simply buying ahead and rotating your stores, should be at the top of your list of important things to consider. The very minimum reserves should carry you over the first couple of weeks of any disaster, natural or man-made. By having this accomplished, you can concentrate your initial efforts on things other than simply

finding something to eat. There will be plenty of others competing for food and it won't be a pretty sight!

This brings us to an important consideration and that is the need for security — first in keeping secret the fact that you have food stored. Those same people who will ridicule you today and call you paranoid for taking such precautions will be the first at your door to share your bounty if trouble strikes. Remember the fable of the ant and the grasshopper? The grasshopper perished, while the ant survived on his stores.

The same security applies to your firearms. Especially those black, wicked looking ones. If you must have any weapon exposed, be sure its a regular looking “sporting” weapon that will not attract undue attention. Remember, the average Joe is accustomed to having a box or two of shotgun shells and likewise with his rifle and handgun ammo. A few boxes of .22's at the most. Stash away to your hearts desire — what we're talking about is what's in sight.

Your overall appearance should be normal to your surroundings. Keep your feeling to your self. Avoid such things as inflammatory bumper stickers or anything that calls undue attention to you.

Remember the actions of our Minutemen forefathers. They took no deadly action until the British made the first move. At the same time they did conduct underground activities by spying on the British, had secret means of communicating and were able to stay one up most of the time. Many American Patriots are choosing to form militia units. This may be to your liking. However, the better ones are made up of men who have been family or friends for a long time and can have a high degree of trust among themselves.

They are not going to accept an unknown into their group.

What this book has emphasized mainly is underground operations. For every combatant there must be support by at least four non-combatants.

We're going to end this chapter by listing several typical questions that the average reader will have and give the best answer we can at this time.

**Question:** I would like to become active in a patriotic underground group. How do I go about finding such a group to join?

**Answer:** If you should find an existing group that will accept new members proceed with caution, if at all! Imagine for a minute that you are in a tight knit group of a few people who are either family, friends or people who have known each other for a long time and have mutual trust and security. Would you want to accept someone into your group who is an unknown? Many problems of the Minutemen of the 60's came from the desire to acquire great numbers and in the process of recruiting, too many infiltrators and misfits were accepted.

**Question:** If you advise against joining an existing underground group how can I aid the cause?

**Answer:** You have aided the cause just by learning what this handbook has presented. If you possess or learn leadership qualities, then, at the proper time you will know how to form your own group from people you know and trust as both stable and patriotic Americans.

**Question:** I don't think I have the ability for things that might deal in physical violence — Is there something else I could do to help the cause?

**Answer:** Your contribution is the greatest when you utilize the skills and talents you naturally possess. In the Minuteman organization of the 60's most new recruits wanted to be part of a combat team. I suppose that this was a natural reaction for someone who was aware of the sellout of our country to want to kick some ass. However, remember that for one active underground combatant, there needs to be at least four or more non-combatants for support in many areas.

**Question:** Suppose that I form a group of a few friends and relatives — How do I maintain good security?

**Answer:** Good question. One good way to learn what makes for good security is to observe what has happened to existing groups. The CIA is about as professional and secure an organization in existence, yet witness the top level security problems they have had in recent times. Other U.S. intelligence organizations have had their security problems too. Things of a secure nature should be known to as few as possible. Remember this rule: Your security risks increase proportional to the square of the number of people involved! Confused? Think of it like this: A covert activity must be done. The very best situation you can have is to simply do it yourself — period. If you have one more person involved then your potential security risk has increased by a factor of 4 (the square of 2). If four people are involved then the risk has increased by a factor of 16 and so on.

Your best bet is to eliminate problems by associating only with stable, trustworthy people. Avoid the braggart, liar, anyone driven to excessive drinking, someone heavy in debt. You should, also, question associating with someone who has an obsession for illegal weaponry and explosives. Knowledge of such is desirable, not

the open and careless display of such items.

**Question:** On the subject of weapons — How can a person or group avoid unnecessary trouble with federal authorities?

**Answer:** At sometime in the too near future it may be next to impossible to avoid some problems due to increasing laws and regulations designed to make all law abiding citizens potential criminals. However, at this time avoid illegal machine guns, silencers, shotguns that are cut off too short, destructive devices etc. For most underground operations machine guns only waste precious ammunition. It should be noted that most of the legal problems that entangled the Minutemen of the 60's centered around illegally-owned machine guns. If you are interested in firearms, then, obtain as much knowledge about all military weapons in use today. Someday you may have to use a weapon taken from occupying forces!

With the passage and signing of the recent crime bill, many other semi-automatic weapons could cause as much legal hassle as full-auto ones. The best advice is to obtain your needs as soon as possible and then run silent and deep as far as weapons are concerned. There are other items of equipment of equal importance you might consider if you have the skills to use them. Printing and photographic equipment are a good example along with radio communication gear. Every group should have the tools, supplies and knowledge to reload ammunition.

America has become vulnerable in many areas — so many in fact that it is hard to prescribe a definite course of action other than to be prepared for any contingency. The military “worst possible situation” is a good philosophy.

Stay low and keep your powder dry!
