

Minuteman Handbook

— Introduction —

With the current erosion of the U.S. Constitution and the trampling of our Second Amendment rights, a growing number of Americans foresee troubled days ahead, not unlike those of our forefathers in 1775. If you fall into this category, don't feel alone — Americans by the hundreds are forming militia units preparing to give serious resistance to overbearing abuse by our socialist leaning, one world bent, federal government.

In addition to the militia units, many Americans are organizing into close-knit underground groups, which are preparing to wage guerrilla warfare in support of the more open militia units. This book has been prepared as an aid to anyone wishing to prepare themselves to survive.

The narratives in this handbook begin in 1775 and describes what our forefathers sacrificed to give us our Constitution and the freedoms it guaranteed. The title "Minuteman" arose from this area and depicted ordinary people who, at a minute's notice, could bear arms in defense of liberty.

The term "Minutemen" was brought into use in 1942, when Americans on our West Coast were preparing for potentially being invaded by the Japanese. Published material from that time has been reproduced in this book.

Later, patriotic writers of inspirational books, used the Minutemen as a patriotic underground whose purpose it was to restore the U.S. Constitution. Beginning at this time, the term Minutemen began to take on the characteristics of an underground, trained in guerrilla & psychological warfare rather than an open military operation as it had begun.

In the early 1960's there developed an organization, which went by the name "Minutemen" and trained in resistance warfare to be able to wage a guerrilla, last ditch stand against a communist takeover from without or within.

The Minuteman Handbook sheds light on all the above and is intended to serve as inspiration, instruction and a guide for today's patriots.
